



We are striving to diversify the educator workforce by providing a pathway into education with support from application to licensure.






My goal is to engage in the facilitation of new teachers' pathways that are fully funded and created in a way that are local and accessible for employees and students.







My goal is to provide future aspiring teachers with needs they may have. Some need housing, tuition paid for, language supports, etc. I make students feel safe.





My goal is to help diversify the Oregon educator workforce by removing financial barriers. All kids need to have teachers who look like them.







I help students get grants so they can continue on their pathways as educators.
